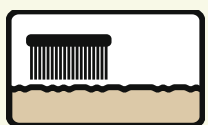
Engineered cross layer - Solid hardwood top layer either 3 or 4mm with a 2mm backing layer and a cross layered soft wood middle. Designed to be installed by floating on underlay or can be stuck down.



Multiply - Solid hard wood top layer either 4 or 6mm bonded to a spruce cross layered ply. Designed to be floated on underlay, secret nailed or stuck down.

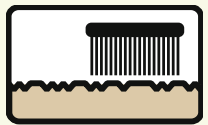


Titan - 6mm hard wood top layer, 6mm hardwood base layer with a soft wood middle cross layer. Designed to be installed floated or fully adhered.



BRUSHED

Your hardwood floor will be mechanically brushed with a coarse wire brush removing the top element of the softer grain from the surface and leaving the tougher grain raised by 1mm enhancing the beauty and character of the hardwood floor.



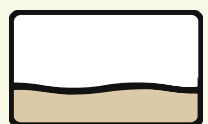
EMBOSSSED

This is a deeper version of brushing. This gives your floor an almost 3D effect by mechanically brushing with a coarse wire brush removing the top element of the softer grain from the surface, and leaving the tougher grain raised by about 3mm enhancing the natural character and grains of your wood floor.



DISTRESSED

The wood floor boards have gone through a process to give you the impression of ageing by creating dents and scrapes to the surface and the bevelled edges of each floor board, each piece is hand finished to achieve an authentic aged and worn appearance.



HAND SCRAPPED

Hand-scraping is a process added to your floor boards which gives an undulated bumpy surface to each board. Like aged antiques, each scrape is carried out by hand using traditional methods of sanding and scraping adding to the unique nature of each wood floor board.

Guarantee

Istoria engineered flooring comes with a delamination guarantee, you shall have a 25 year domestic guarantee and 10 year commercial guarantee on a wooden floor from the Istoria collection from the purchase date.

For you to consider

Colour variation is to be expected in all grades of hard wood flooring, this is due to the natural characteristics of a natural material, each floor board is like a finger print unique in nature and **NO** two boards are exactly alike. This is just one of the elements that add to the natural beauty of having a hardwood floor.

Colour variation can be minimized but never totally eliminated by choosing a cleaner grade of timber.

A select or prime grade will have less colour variation than a rustic or character grade.

Istoria wood flooring by Jordan Andrews is divided into different grades to enhance the natural beauty.

The wider the chosen board the more prominent some characteristics will appear. The below is a guide of what to expect and is not absolute. All dimensions are a guide and some tolerance is to be allowed for permitted knots.



PRIME

Prime / Select - Also known as AB grade, prime is our cleanest grade of wood flooring. This would generally give you the following characteristics: No large knots, only sound and inter grown knots permitted of less than 10mm in diameter, no sap wood and minor colour variation, a clean and uniform structure, perfect for your modern and contemporary look.



CHARACTER

Character Grade - Will give your space a vibrancy where your wood floor comes alive with, Sap wood permitted, live and filled knots up to 6cm diameter, clear colour variation between the boards and small filled splits and cracks. There is also a large difference between the grains. Perfect for your contemporary or rustic space where you want your hard wood floor to be a feature.



RUSTIC

Rustic - Also known as CD or country grade, you will find this grade has large unlimited knots, header cracks and cracks of which some are filled, considerable colour variation, sap wood and streaks included. This grade is full of vibrant colour and is a popular choice and can enhance your space.



NATURAL

Natural Grade - Will give you a wood floor with minor sapwood, no splits or cracks, live and filled knots up to 4 cm diameter, slight colour variations, a bit more of a lively look. You can use this grade to complement any design project where you want a wood floor.
